

Mexico Missions Trip

TAKING APPLICATIONS THROUGH FRI 2/28



We're starting to build our missions team for Mexico this summer! Mexico is a great missions trip for first-timers, because the program is so well run, and year after year our youth have come back transformed by their experience of God.

Trip Cost: \$1150, including airfare, room and board, program fees, and travel visa

Extra Cost: \$650 per person (estimated for a 20-person team) to support our HOUSE BUILD

HOUSE BUILD

This year we're excited to be donating supplies and labor to build a fully furnished home for a family in need.

The house build will take 3 days of ministry, leaving another two days to go to church and visit other outreach locations, as we've done on previous trips. In addition, the site of the build. itself often creates opportunities for us to outreach to the neighborhood kids and families.



While building there are plenty of jobs for youth of all ages, including sanding, nailing, and painting.


SUPPORT RAISING
