

HIGH SCHOOL SUNDAY SCHOOL READING THE BIBLE WITH YOUR LIFE

Now they're ready to jump back into a book study that allows them do dive deeply into the specific verses of the Bible and be encouraged and built up by Peter's words to the exiles of the early church.
